• Totals in brackets are adjusted estimates upon the 2004 Ohio Family Health Survey baseline findings to the 2006 and 2007 Ohio Health Issues Polls (Ohio Poll) and the 2004-2006 aggregate Current Population Survey – *Effect Size* software was used to compute expected values within these brackets (Shadish, 2003).

* Ohio's most current uninsured rate (summer 2007) is estimated 17.7%, or approximately 1,265,000 adults between 18-64 years.

** Cells in italics are unreliable due to high standard errors associated with small cell counts. Shadowed cells covered zero in their confidence intervals.
